**Priority A:** Required items, including code violations and health and safety issues. These items must be completed prior to consideration of general, non-essential property improvements.

**Priority B:** General property improvements. Items to be completed if budget allows.

Priority Letter	Priority Number	Item Description
A	1	Roof Coating: Apply a silicone coating per manufacturer's instructions. Scrape and power spray as needed or otherwise prepare the surface and spray/roll on a high-quality silicone with emphasis on pipe/vent protrusions. Note: Please try to address transition from roof to awning where water now backs up and leaks down the side of the house.
A	2	Appliances: <b>Replace the electric cooktop and kitchen hood.</b> a. Cooktop: replace like for like as possible for size. The allowance for this product is \$800.00. b. Hood: replace like for like if possible. If the 48" width is not available then center a wide hood and install simple panels on left and right to integrate with cabinet cut-out. The allowance for this product is \$350.00. Note: Ensure that connection to electrical is up to code and all

		parts are secure and connected per manufacturers instructions. Note: permit required.
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**Exclusions:** Any items not included in the above scope of work.
