A	2	Electrical Improvements: Upgrade electrical service to dwelling – Unless otherwise noted, system is to maintain existing amperage. a. Disconnect and dispose of existing panel and fit and mount new panel to code. Price to include planning, equipment and material acquisition, area preparation and protection, setup and cleanup. All abandoned conduit, plugs and boxes to be removed.
	3	Contractor is responsible for obtaining and submitting all documents required to secure a building permit as required by local and state ordinance, including plan review and inspections fees. Contractor is assumed to be professional and knowledgeable regarding when permits are required for contracted Work. Contractor is responsible for submitting all receipts and other rights to payment along with invoices. If costs exceed the amount specified, said costs shall be accounted for in a Change Order and approved by the homeowner. If the amount is less than the amount specified it will be subtracted from the final amount of the contract.
	4	Construction Contingency Additional funding to cover unforeseen construction and project related expenses. All changes to the contract price must be approved by owner and administrator by change order.
