		a. Demo, haul and properly dispose of existing countertops, sink,
		faucet and disposal, and appliances. Any appliances being retained
		and reinstalled are to be moved and properly protected until
		reinstallation.
		b. Install new countertop and backsplash. Backsplash to be



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		standard 6" to match countertop, with full height behind range.	
		c. Replace existing sink and faucet. Connect to new braided supply	
		lines and new P-trap assembly.	
		d. Repair existing drawers and cabinet door hardware as	
		needed.
