Priority A: Required items, including code violations and health and safety issues. <u>These items must be completed prior to consideration of general, non-essential property improvements.</u> **Priority B:** General property improvements. Items to be completed if budget allows.

A	1	Foundation Corrections Comply with corrections to foundation as shown in approved plans provided by engineer. Inspector Note: Mobile Home foundation in need of stabilization and reinforcement. Gaps in skirting has cause weather damage and rodent problem. Insulation replacement also needed.
A	2	Inspector Note: Work to exclude accessory structures. Replace visible dry rotted or damaged wood including crawlspace access doors, trim around vents and window/door casing and sills, fascia and rafter tails. Replace Mobile Unit Skirting for entire exterior of unit.

Exclusions: Any items not included in the above scope of work, including:

- a. Correction of existing unpermitted work not disclosed to Habitat or contractor.
- b. Costs related to temporary displacement of occupants.



c. Costs related to storage of homeowner's belongings during duration of project.
