A	1	Replace Sewer Lateral Work is dependent on results of video inspection prior to project bidding. --- Remove and replace existing sewer lateral using trenchless method unless otherwise noted. See third party report for details. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Demo and excavate as necessary to expose sewer line and all sewer exit lines and wye connections.2. Using trenchless method, replace sewer lateral from the foundation to the property line in the street using 4" HDPE pipe.3. Install new two-way clean outs on all exit lines at the foundation and new wye connections using proper couplings. Install new two way clean out at the property line and foundation/driveway per industry standards. Make any necessary alterations to sewer stack as required per code.4. Backfill holes with proper compaction and restore the grade, concrete, and property to pre-construction conditions.

		<p>5. Price to include labor, material, special equipment, permit, inspection, and air pressure verification test (if applicable). Partial replacement has been done over 10yrs ago.</p>
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- Exclusions:** Any items not included in the above scope of work, including:
- a. Correction of existing unpermitted work not disclosed to Habitat or contractor;
